



NEWDAY TRIP 2026

Dear parent/guardians,

I am writing to you to let you know that we are planning a trip to Newday camping festival this year. It is a Christian camp, and aimed at young people who want to investigate more about the Christian faith. It is 5 nights, with loads of fantastic activities to do. This will be our fifth year attending the camp.

There are very limited spaces to this trip, we are only opening it to 30 young people who have demonstrated that they are trustworthy.

WHEN AND WHERE?

The trip will leave Manchester on Monday 27th July, and return on Saturday 1st August. All other details so far are provisional, and we will get further details to you when we are able to.

WHAT IS THE TRIP?

The trip is to a festival called Newday, which is held in the Norfolk Showground near Norwich. Similarly to Revolution Youth, Newday is a Christian event at its heart, though much like our youth group, is very open and welcoming to people of all faiths and none. The trip is aimed at those who want to find out more about the Christian faith, or who already consider themselves Christians. You don't need your own camping equipment - though if you have any you can bring, please let us know.

WHAT IS THE COST?

We are asking £30 per child who will be attending - the full cost to us is over £300 per young person, so we're asking for a contribution of just 10%. Where it may be possible, we'd also ask you to consider making an additional donation to help cover these costs as a charity.

WHAT WILL THE TRIP INVOLVE?

We will write to you nearer to the time about exact details involving leaving times, items needed, specific rules, etc. The Newday festival is a very exciting opportunity for young people, with around 8,000 teenagers from around the UK who will be there. There will be loads of activities, gig nights, cafes, sports activities, games and more!

Each day starts with a meeting for all the attendees on the entire campsite, then we will meet back together as Revolution for lunch. After lunch there is an afternoon of activities, sports, live music, and more all around the campsite, all of which are optional (but free) - some young people might prefer to stay with Revolution where we will also have games and time to relax (and maybe the odd water fight...). Then we will eat together as Revolution, and then there is another evening meeting with live music. The meetings have a theme based around exploring faith and Christianity, and although the meetings are a requirement to be at, there is no expectation that your child will share those beliefs, as long as they are respectful of them and happy to learn more about them. This is similar to Revolution's sessions which are based around issues like mental health, self image, relationships etc., which we share with the young people through a Christian worldview.

The trip is a brilliant opportunity to build relationships, try new things, and have a holiday away, all in a safe, welcoming environment.

HOW TO APPLY FOR YOUR SPACE

Your child should apply to come on our website, www.revolutionyouth.co.uk. This application should be made by the child, not a parent/guardian. We will then contact the parent/guardian if your child is successful in applying.
